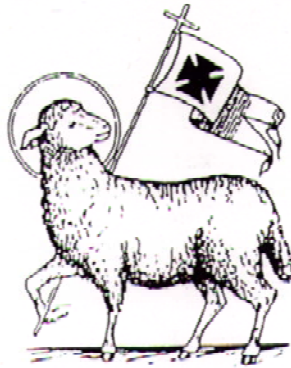

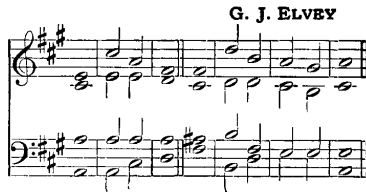

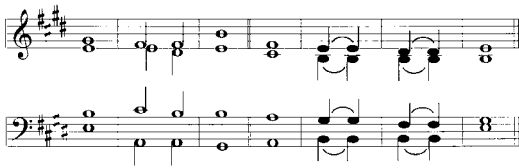

Almighty God, unto whom all hearts are open, all desires known, and from whom no secrets are hid; cleanse the thoughts of our hearts by the inspiration of thy Holy Spirit, that we may perfectly love thee, and worthily magnify thy holy Name; through Christ our LORD. *Amen.*

FOR THOSE WHO ARE SICK

Lord Jesus, who for our sakes wast once a little child, and didst show thy love for children by taking them up into thine arms and blessing them; we ask thee to bless those who are sick (*especially...*). Thy love toward them is greater than ours can ever be; therefore, O Lord, we trust them to thy care and keeping, beseeching thee to grant them renewed health and strength according to thy will. *Amen.*

Question. **What is your duty towards God in the first and second commandments?**

Question. **What is your duty towards God in the third commandment?**

Answer. To honor his holy Name and his Word.

Question. **What is your duty towards God in the fourth commandment?**

Answer. To serve him truly all the days of my life.

Question. **What is your duty towards God in the fifth commandment?**

Answer. To love, honor, and help my father and mother: To honor and obey the civil authority: To submit myself to all my governors, teachers, spiritual pastors and masters: And to order myself in that lowliness and reverence which becometh a servant of God.

Question. **What is your duty towards your neighbor?**

Answer. My duty towards my neighbor is to love him as myself, and to do to all men as I would they should do unto me.

Question. **What is your duty towards your neighbor in the sixth commandment?**

Answer. To hurt no one by word or deed: To bear no malice nor hatred in my heart.

Question. **What is your duty towards your neighbor in the seventh commandment?**

Answer. To keep my body in temperance, soberness, and chastity.

Question. **What is your duty towards your neighbor in the eighth commandment?**

Answer. To keep my hands from stealing: To be true and just in all my dealings.

Question. **What is your duty towards your neighbor in the ninth commandment?**

Answer. To keep my tongue from evil speaking, lying, and slandering.

Question. **What is your duty towards your neighbor in the tenth commandment?**

Answer. Not to covet nor desire other men's goods; But to learn and labor truly to earn mine own living, And to do my duty in that state of life unto which it shall please God to call me.
